## Who Is Eligible?

LGBT high school seniors in Erie, Crawford, Mercer, Venango and Warren counties enrolled in an accredited university, college, vocational or technical school for 2017-18 as a full-time or half-time student.\*

## Amounts Available

Up to three scholarships will be awarded. Scholarships for \$2,000 are available for full-time students. Scholarships for \$1,000 are available for half-time students.

## Application Deadline

May 1, 2017

## Awards Announcement

Scholarships will be presented at GEAE's Afternoon for Equality celebration on June 11, 2017.

## How To Apply | Each applicant must send the following —

- A typed, one-page letter outlining why he or she deserves the scholarship.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator at his or her current high school.
- Written verification from the university or technical school he or she will be attending. Documents such as course schedules, letters from academic advisors or other school officials, or similar official verifications are permitted. An acceptance letter is not enough.


